



Scholarship Requirements Form

Please Check off these Application Requirements to ensure your complete package:

Step 1 - Print a copy of, and complete both the requirements form and the application form.

Step 2 - Submit 10 (ten) images of work that you have completed in jpeg or on a CD. Each image clearly labelled when opened with Image Number, Image Title, Medium and Image Size

With a permanent black marker, on the CD write: **FCA Scholarship** __?__ (the institution in which you are resuming studies) **First name - Last name**

The digital files on the CD must be in JPG/JPEG format and PC/MAC compatible. When opened, only the image of the artwork should show (with no frame or extraneous background showing).

Image file names on the CD numbers to correspond with titles as listed

Image size should not exceed 10 inches on any one side with approx. 300 dpi resolution.

File should be set on Medium to High quality setting for JPEG compression. No larger than 2MB. CDs will not be returned unless a correct postage paid and addressed envelope is included.

Step 3 - Letter of Reference from Instructor

Step 4 - Proof of registration into 3rd of Bachelor studies in designated visual art program

Step 5 - Proof of grade point average

Step 6 - Essay element (max. 500 words) What art means to you - What your art degree fulfills for your goals or your vision

By submitting this application and affixing your signature to it you are:

A - Confirming that the accompanying works are not copies, derivatives, or based in any way on other copyrighted or published paintings, photographs, or other artistic works; that the works are entirely your work, executed without direct intervention of an instructor or other person, and completed within three years preceding the application deadline;

B - Agreeing that all decisions of the jurors are final and cannot be contested.

C - Agreeing that If Successful your photograph will be published on the FCA web site and in the FCA newsletter

D You will be present to collect your scholarship award and display two original works of Art at the FCA 30th Anniversary on Sept 17th 2011

Eligibility Requirements

1. Registered in a Bachelor in fine arts (visual studies - ie: painting) program with within the province of Alberta in the following institutions: U of C, U of A or ACAD
2. Entering 3rd year
3. Letter of reference from 1 instructor
4. Grade point over 2.75
5. Essay content element 400-500 words. What art means to you - What your art degree fulfills for your goals or your vision
6. 10 pieces for jury. (via jpeg) Artworks (2) must be available to be on show at the FCA 30th Anniversary Celebration □ Sat. Sept 17th
7. Award will be presented at the 30th anniversary - in Calgary
8. Must prove registration to institute with receipt before funds are released unless institution governs release of funds.
9. Deadline September 1
10. Denomination - \$1000.00 for the University of Alberta and \$1000.00 for the University of Calgary, In the case of Alberta College of Art and Design \$500

Application Information

1. Applications must be complete or will be rejected. Full packages must include registration form, letter of reference, essay, and proof of grade point average for the completion of year two (some restrictions may apply) and jpeg images must be forwarded to email at time of application.
2. Applications received after the deadline of Sept. 1 are not eligible
3. Application will only be sent back if appropriate addressed envelope and postage are included in the package at the time of receipt.
4. Jpegs may be sent via email or on a disc - these may be viewed by the decision making committee and/or by the general membership.
